What's Happening this Month @ SMH?

Last month we welcomed our new Chaplain, Rev. Elizabeth Gillett. Here's a little bit about Rev. Gillett:

The Rev. Elizabeth R.H. Gillett was born into the Anglican Church in England, and lived in Botswana, Canada, and Australia before coming to the United States at the age of twelve. She graduated from high school in Baltimore, Maryland, and has had an affectionate relationship with that city ever since.

Elizabeth earned a B.A. in English Literature from Columbia University, in New York City. She received her Master's of Divinity from the General Theological Seminary in New York City.

Elizabeth was ordained to the transitional diaconate in 1983 and to the priesthood in 1984 from the Diocese of Maryland. She started as a Priest Associate at the Church of the Redeemer in Baltimore. She then moved to the Diocese of Central New York, to be a Canon at the then St. Paul's Cathedral in Syracuse. Followed by becoming Rector of St. Thomas', Hamilton for ten years. Elizabeth then moved back to Baltimore to become the Executive Director of Episcopal Social Ministries (ESM). As the Executive Director of ESM, she oversaw four spiritually based programs in East Baltimore's ghetto.

Following her husband's death, Elizabeth moved back to Hamilton, New York, returning to the Diocese of Central New York, and decided to retire. Although technically retired, it was not actually to be. Soon she was doing long term supply for parishes and returned to St. Thomas', Hamilton serving as Interim Rector. Elizabeth is now beginning her fourth year as part-time parish priest with the people of the Episcopal Church of the Epiphany, in Sherburne New York. She also is a spiritual director; a fellow of the Weinberg Foundation, in Baltimore; President of the William R. McNeiece, III Foundation, here in Central New York; and is an active Associate of the (Episcopal) Order of the Holy Cross, whose monastery is in West Park, New York, her second home.

She is now looking forward to her next adventure as part-time Chaplain with the communities of St. Margaret's House and Emmaus House. Services will be held Wednesdays & Fridays @12pm at SMH.


