The Shrine is located on 350 acres in the Berkshires of Massachusetts in an area known as Eden Hill. Upon arrival you can visit the **gift shop** or **explore the grounds as you choose**. **Confessions, Eucharistic Adoration and Rosary** take place between 1:00 and 2:00pm, followed by **Mass** at 2pm. **The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy** and **Benediction** follow the mass at 3pm.

The Café is not open on Monday but you can enjoy your own lunch at the sheltered outside area with picnic tables.

**Be advised the buildings on the grounds are handicapped accessible but all pilgrims to the site must be able to navigate on their own as there are no wheelchairs available. Use of a golf cart is based on availability and can not be guaranteed. Pilgrims are encouraged to wear sturdy walking shoes and be prepared for windy and changeable weather on the hill. Umbrellas and appropriate clothing are suggested. Services are sometimes held outside depending on the size of the crowd.*

The bus is not allowed to drop off in front of the Shrine so pilgrims will need to be able to walk from the parking lot to the grounds.
